Fun at Bluebirds in Preschool Room

We have had so much fun and done lots of learning in Preschool Room last month.

Preschool spoke about the different planets and also watched a video of it. They looked at earth and some children mentioned different countries when asked about the earth. They made rocket to go into space and coloured the earth with blue and green in mark marking.

Preschool also learnt about what they use the different parts of the body for. For example, they learnt that nose is for smelling, mouth for eating etc The children felt different textures of materials in sensory play and look at what their favourite taste is in food.

Toddlers and Baby Room

Toddlers and Baby room have had a very busy month too.

Our babies explore painting of aliens through hand painting. They also added glue, glitters, windows, tails to their space rocket.

They experienced their five senses through sensory play using each of their fingers to represent each of their senses.


The fun continued in Toddler's room where they looked at the Moon, the Earth and the Sun. They learnt that the moon come out at night and the sun come out during the day. They also learnt that the earth is green and blue.

Our toddlers also had a guessing game when they had to guess the noises that different animals make by using their ears to listen. A 3D model rocket was made by the children and they took turn to go in it.

Learning at Bluebirds

This month the children will be learning about $oldsymbol{Pets.}$

We will be talking about family pets, how to care for their pet, guess the pet sound, singing animals nursery rhymes, making their own pet, reading animal books like Kipper stories and much more. Your child's key person will let you know what they have learnt each day so you can talk to your child about it.



Let's Get Crafty – SHAPE PUPPY

The shape puppy on the left is a fun craft to make at home to help learn shapes while enjoying talking about one of the nation's favourite pet – Dog. It is easy to put together and your child can choose whichever colours they want to put in their own little personality.

Shapes you will need:

- -one large rectangle for the body
- -one octagon for the head
- -two triangles for the ears
- -one small triangle for the nose
- -one small oval for the tail
- -four small rectangles for the legs
- -four small squares for the feet
- -one long rectangle for the collar (it's not in the picture on the left)
- -one circle for the tag on the collar

What to do:

Cut out shapes and glue them to a different piece of construction paper or card to make a dog. Add googly eyes. Colour the background, if desired.
